Constitutional Court Ruling No. 15/2563 (2020)

The fact that the first respondent informed the meeting about her intent to closely monitor, coordinate and expedite the scrutiny of relevant agencies to speed up the establishment of community forests was merely a follow up of public complaints to ensure that state officials performed duties prescribed by law. The second respondent's meeting with the Minister of Public Health to submit a copy of a written notice of problems concerning shortages of housing for Jom Thong Hospital staff was merely notice of problems given to the Minister of Public Health for acknowledgement. There did not appear to be circumstances indicating participation in the expenditure of public budget funds or the approval of a project under the Ministry of Public Health.

Therefore, the first respondent's membership of the House of Representatives did not terminate under section 101(7) in conjunction with section 185(1) of the Constitution and the second respondent's membership of the House of Representatives did not terminate under section 101(7) in conjunction with section 185(2) of the Constitution.
